SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Because of the decline of COVID numbers and progress with vaccinations, Cardinal Seán and the Catholic bishops of Massachusetts have announced that the lifting of the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligation, effective the weekend of June 19 -20. That means we resume our serious obligation to participate in Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have been recently exposed to COVID or any other communicable illness; those who are confined to their homes or to hospitals or other facilities due to illness, infirmity, frailty, or age; and those who are not yet able to be vaccinated, due to age or any health consideration

MASSES AT SAINT PATRICK'S

Masking

All Masses are now celebrated indoors at Saint Patrick's.

Masks are no longer required for vaccinated people in the state of Massachusetts. If you are vaccinated, you do not need to wear a mask at Mass, but you are certainly welcome to wear a mask if you like.

The state advises that non-vaccinated people continue to wear masks. If you are not vaccinated, please wear a mask at Mass, and maintain social distance from others.

Parishioners are trusted to make sound, responsible decisions about when they take off masks and are near other people.

Daily Masses are celebrated in English on Monday through Saturday at 7:00 am in the lower church and in Spanish on Tuesday and Friday at 7:00 pm in the lower church.

CONFESSIONS

Because of Lawrence's current COVID, we have not yet returned to celebrating Confessions in the confessional or reconciliation room. Confessions are celebrated **in the parish center**, face-to-face only, maintaining social distancing in English on Wednesday at 7:00 pm in Spanish on Tuesday at 6:00 pm.

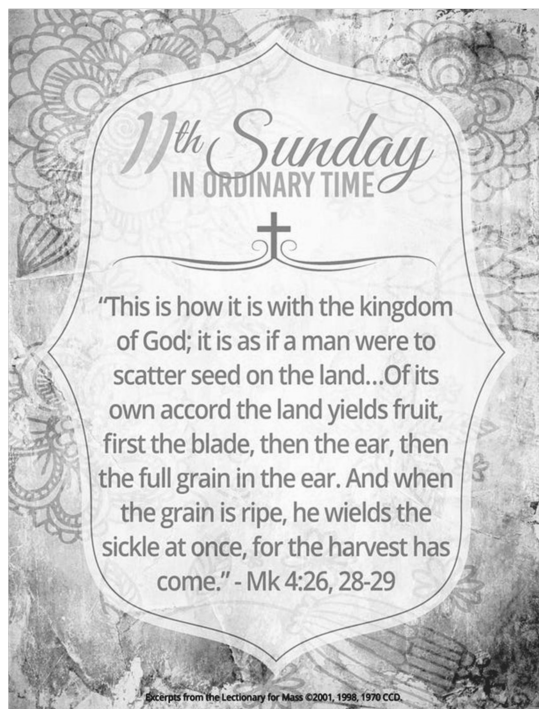
COR UNUM

Español: martes, 6:00 pm iglesia de abajo

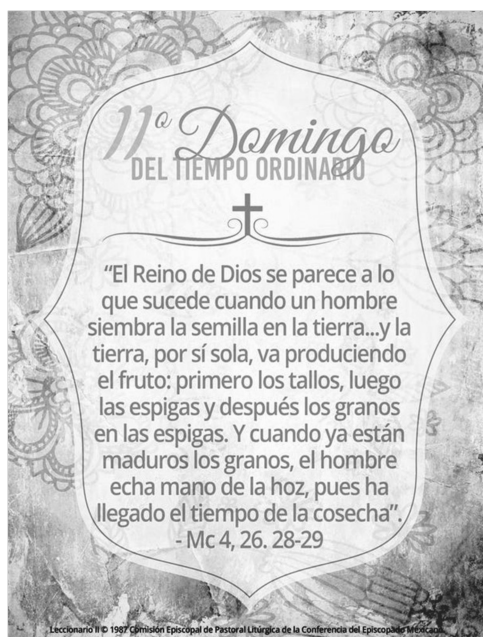
Cor Unum
